## Distribution of Applicant Test Scores by Test Version:









- On average, applicants scoring 1 represent 6.9% of total applicants and applicants scoring represent 4.5%.
- Thus, if adjustment to test question result in a decrease of two incorrect answers on average, the overall test pass rates should rise by about 11%, which would bring the overall pass rate above 80%.
