Report on Citizenship Test Results August 2010

Notes:

The report is in two sections, reflecting the two distinct (and non-commensurable) data sources used in its construction. The first is drawn from local office test reports, which distinguish between test versions and, crucially, separate first-time tests from re-tests, allowing us to see that access to re-testing has so far raised the overall success rate from 75% to 80%.

The second section draws on the Global Case Management System (GCMS), which provides demographic data but cannot distinguish re-tests from first tries. Since applicant success on re-tests is much lower – these are people who have already failed once – their inclusion somewhat paradoxically reduces the overall pass rate in this section to 71%. It also tends to amplify demographic differences.
